

Upgrading to latest version of Baghdad.

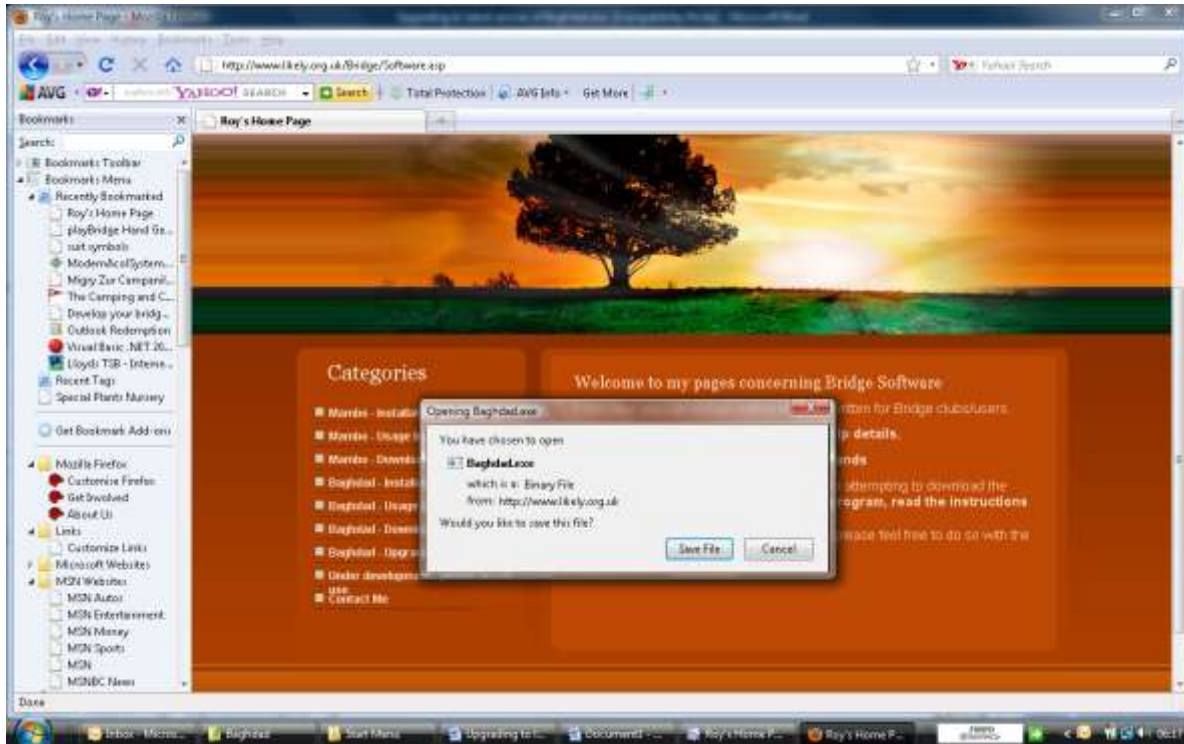
Once you have installed Baghdad you can upgrade to the latest version by two methods.

- 1) Baghdad itself will allow registered users to download automatically the latest version of the program and database. However, this technique does cause some issues with some Firewall software.
- 2) You can also download latest versions direct for the web site
- 3)

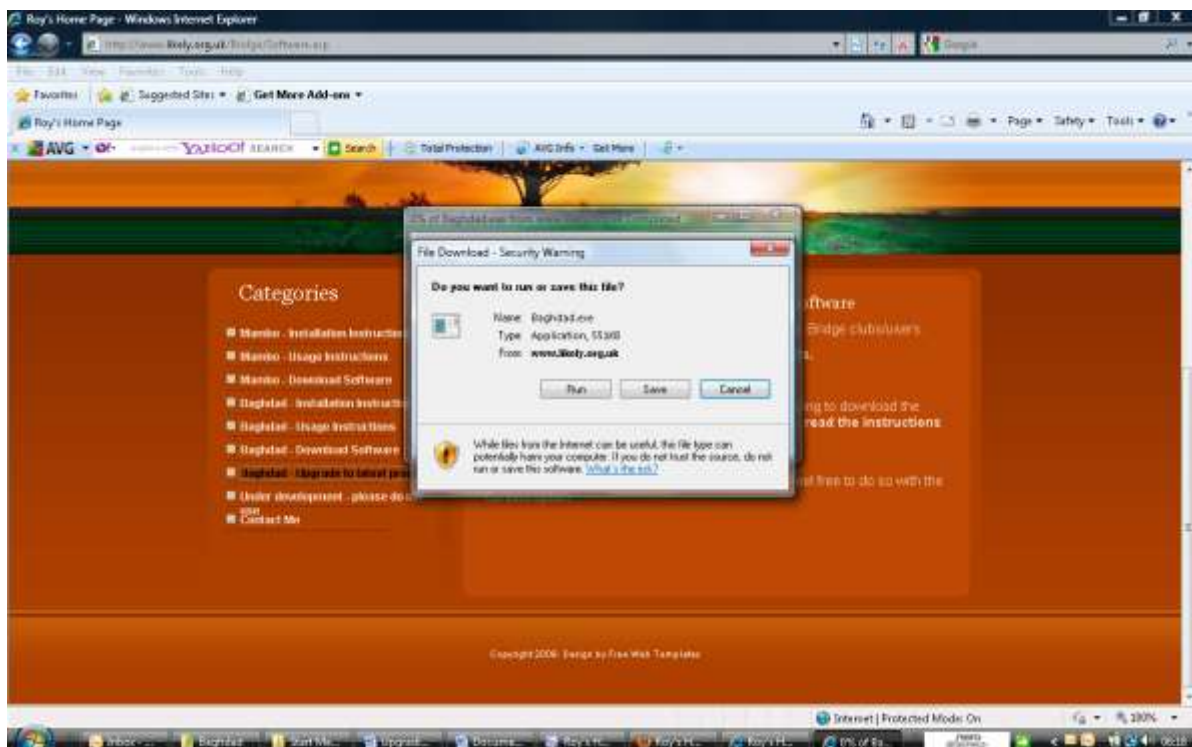
To Upgrade Baghdad do the following:

First click on the link on the Website -- > **Baghdad – Upgrade to latest program**

You should get a pop up window, similar to below

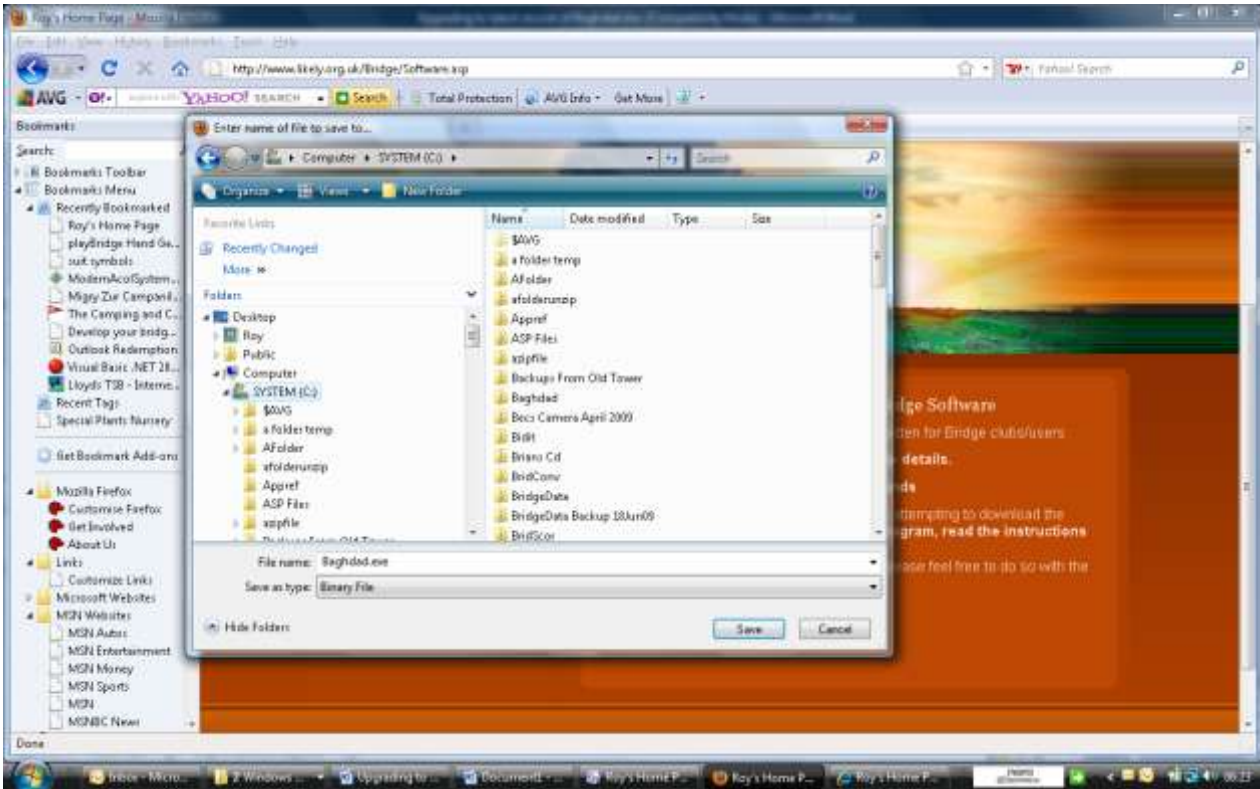

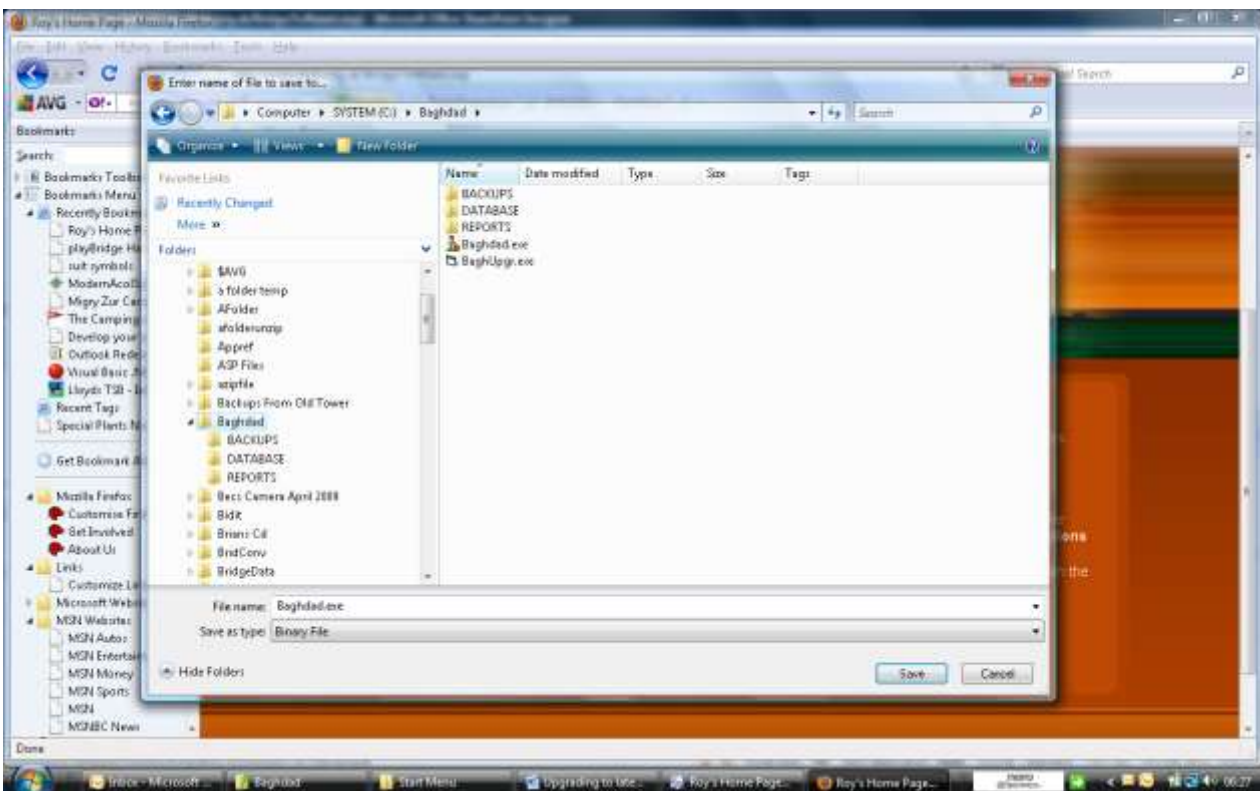
In either case select the "Save file" or "Save" option.

You will then be presented with a normal Windows Explorer screen displaying your directory structure for your computer, It will be similar to this

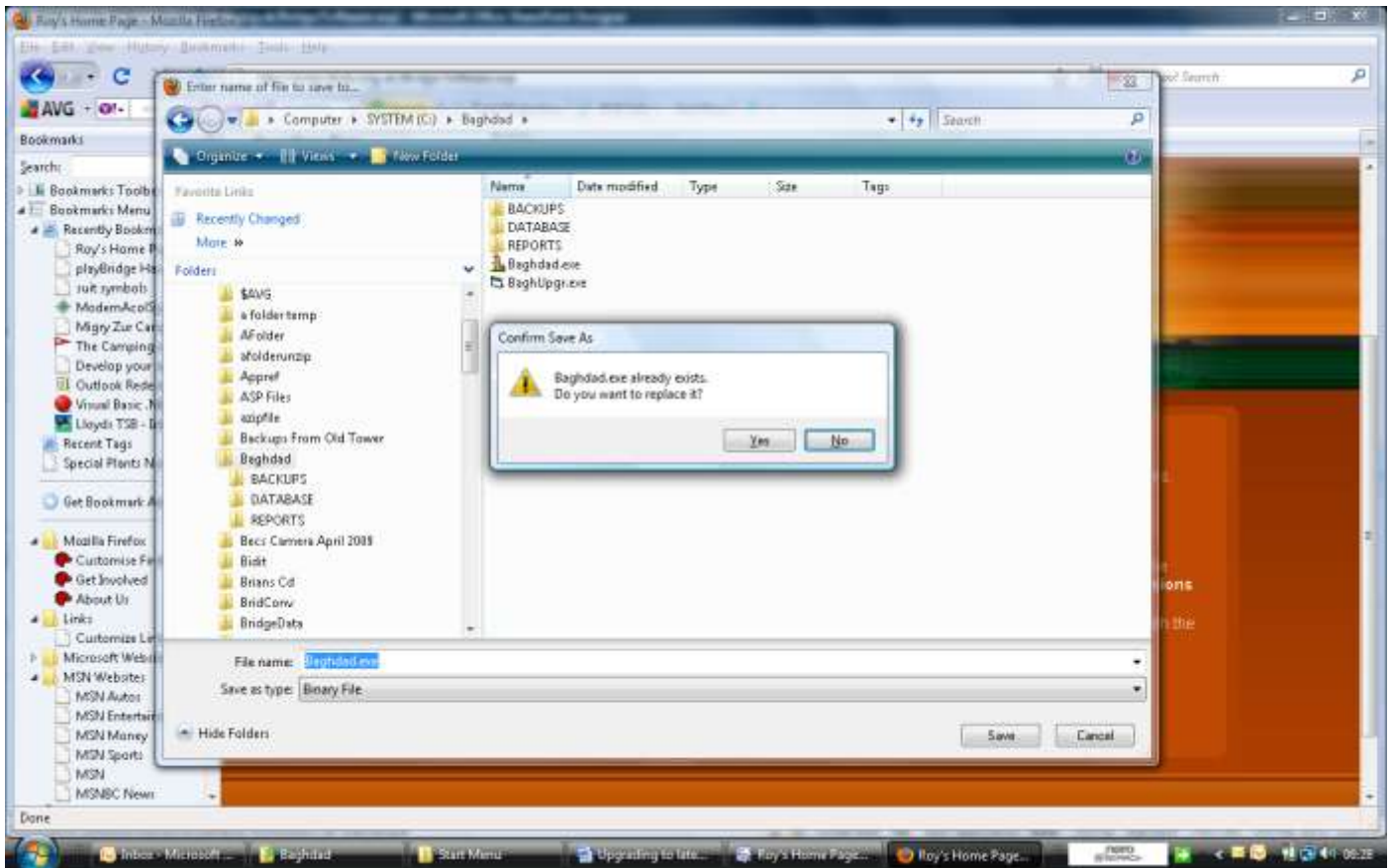


In the left hand panel scroll down/up to find the Baghdad folder on your C drive and left click with the mouse that folder.

The screen should now contain



Click "Save", and you will get the pop up message, saying that Baghdad.exe already exists – click Yes to replace.



After a few seconds you should get a message/pop up to say that downloads are complete.

To upgrade to the latest version of the database perform exactly the same procedures as above – this time however the file that is downloaded will be “InstallDB.txt” – it should be placed in exactly the same directory as the Baghdad.exe as described above.

You can then run the latest version of Baghdad. It will automatically reconfigure itself – you do not need to get a new access code. It will automatically upgrade its database from any downloaded new version.
